2020 Scholarship Grant Application



In order to be considered for a WenEA Scholarship Grant, application forms and essays must be received on-site at the WSD District Office or WenEA office by 4:00 pm on April 15th.

90-second video versions of essays must be received by Adam MacDonald at macdonald.a@wenatcheeschools.org by 4:00 pm on April 15th.

Incomplete or late submissions of forms, essays, and videos will NOT be considered.

General Information: The size of awards varies each year. They are based upon the amount of donations received from WenEA members and the number of applicants, and are equally distributed to all eligible applicants. Grants will only be awarded to children of members of the Wenatchee Education Association (WenEA) who are current high school seniors, regardless of the school they attend.

Essay: Applicants must write a paragraph about their parent who is a member of the WenEA and submit it with their completed application form prior to the submission deadline. They must send a video of themselves reading their essay (no longer than 90 seconds) to: Adam MacDonald at macdonald.a@wenatcheeschools.org.

Essay prompt: In a well-developed paragraph, please answer one or more of the following questions:
How has your parent's role as an educator influenced your life? What have you learned about education from your parent? How has your parent encouraged you to find success in your life?

Check Distribution: Grant checks will be issued no later than August 31st, and will only be written to one (1) institution. The checks will be mailed directly to the institution's Office of Financial Aid. The student's Social Security Number is necessary to credit the student with the grant. Colleges will not accept funds without this number.

Deferral: Grants may be deferred for up to one (1) year. Recipients must notify WenEA Treasurer Adam MacDonald (macdonald.a@wenatcheeschools.org) of their school choice or deferment by June 15th in order to remain eligible for the scholarship.

Awards Ceremonies: Recipients and their parents are encouraged to attend the WenEA Year-End Celebration. Students will be recognized and their video essay shared. WenEA will also arrange for recipients to be acknowledged at their schools' senior awards events.
